The Bank specifically reserves the right to switch the authentication procedure for users with tokens to SMS log-in and vice-versa. Any changes to authentication procedures shall be communicated to users in an appropriate manner.

Users who lose their mobile phone must inform the Bank promptly, and arrange for their service provider to block it immediately.

The Bank's General Terms of Contract (including the Safe Custody and Metal Account Regulations) shall form an integral part of this Statement. The User acknowledges the contents thereof and consents to them in full. The User further confirms receipt of the 'Conditions for the Use of E-services' which form an integral part of this statement and consents to them in full.

All legal relations between the User and the Bank are governed by **Swiss substantive law**. The place of performance and debt collection for Users domiciled abroad and the **place of jurisdiction** for all legal proceedings is **the City of Basel or the location of the Swiss branch of the Bank with which the business relationship is maintained**. The Bank is entitled to take legal action against the User before the competent court at his place of residence or business, or before any other competent court or any other competent entity or authority in Switzerland or abroad. Here too, Swiss substantive law shall continue to apply.
